Administrators can customise the tile-based catalogue to show the information your learners learners should review prior to enrolment. With an array of display and content options, the learning catalog is an engaging navigation and decision making tool for your learners.

BUILD YOUR LEARNING CATALOGUE

Course managers can create individual courses as required, choosing from a range of design, access and enrolment options. A dedicated upload area supports the bulk creation of courses via a simple .csv file.

Programs and certifications can include any number of courses and offer adaptive learning pathways for your staff. With a range of completion options, administrators can build programs that learners can work through at the pace and order that works best for them and their role.


Courses can be easily moved between Totara Learn sites using the step-bystep backup and restore process, and activities and resources shared between courses with the import tool.

ORGANISE YOUR LEARNING MATERIAL

Catalogue items are stored within categories and sub-categories, allowing you to structure and organise learning and development content into areas that make sense for your learners and your organisation.

Courses, programs, certifications and activities can be further categorised using official or ad hoc tags. Learners browsing the catalogue can search and filter on these tags, allowing them to drill into the content most suited to their development needs.

With the ability to set default or custom images and icons for each course, program and certification within your Totara Learn site, your learning catalogue can not only be visually appealing, but allow learners to see at a glance the subject and type of each learning item offered.

Administrators and course managers can leverage a range of custom fields to add bespoke, organisation specific information to each catalogue item. Whether you're highlighting a management track course, indicating the number of hours of learning required, or identifying a CPD course, custom fields can be filters and search criteria within your catalogue.
